

Financial Reporting Quiz

Where would you put:

- Q: \$45 you collected from some of your parents to register their girls during Early Bird.
A: Income – National Registration Dues
- Q: \$20 per girl you collected for general troop supplies for the year.
A: Income – Troop/Group Dues
- Q: \$78 the girls earned selling the nuts and candy in October.
A: Income – Fall Product Sale
- Q: \$193 the girls made at a Bake Sale.
A: Income - Other Money Earning Projects
- Q: \$12 per girl you collected and then paid to GSWO for Junior Bridging Day at Stonybrook.
A: Income – Program Fees – Events or Outdoor/Camping – up to you, then Expenses – Program Activity Fees – Events or Outdoor/Camping – just make sure it's listed the same for both.
- Q: \$90 you paid to GSWO for reserving Squirrel Hollow at Butterworth.
A: Expenses – Program Activity Fees – Outdoor/Camping
- Q: \$30 you spent at Walmart on fleece so your girls could make blankets for Project Linus.
A: Expenses – Service Projects (or you could put it under Supplies – Program if it was specifically to earn a part of a Journey or a badge – it's up to you)
- Q: \$27 for a First Aid kit.
A: Expenses – Supplies – General (or you could put it under Supplies – Program if it was specifically to earn a part of a Journey or a badge – it's up to you)
- Q: \$11 you sent to GSWO for additional insurance for a family camping trip.
A: Expenses – Program Activity Fees – Trips, or Outdoor/Camping – however you list the rest of the expenses, and depending on how far the camping trip is.
- Q: \$37 for S'Mores supplies for the family camping trip (families brought the other food items).
A: Expenses – Supplies – Program, or Expenses - Program Activity Fees – Trips if you decided it was a trip and not camping.
- Q: \$125 spent at GSWO Shop on badges, pins, fun patches and some small cute gifts for Bridging and your adult volunteers.
A: Divide the receipt between Expenses – Earned Recognitions and Other, or if it's mostly for the girls, just use Earned Recognitions. Don't sweat it.
