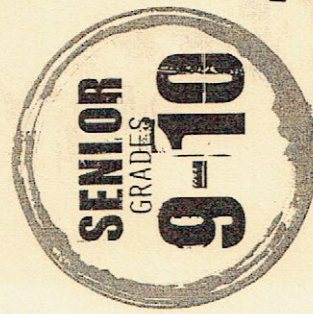

This is the perfect opportunity to complete your Journey prerequisite for the Gold Award!



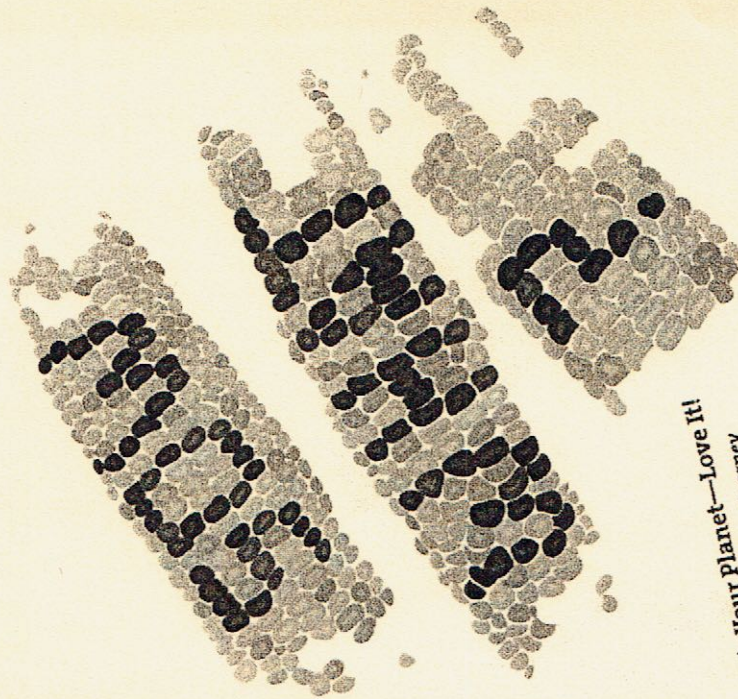

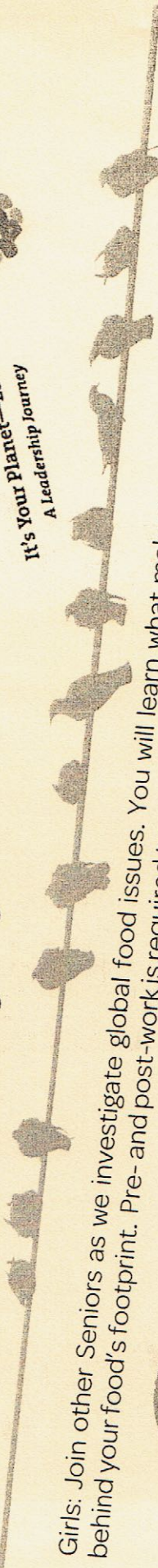


